Training-New presidents orientation

DA Bob Toigo covered instructions for holding elections, reviewing constitutions and local league rules, charters, insurance and financial statements. Leagues are encouraged to submit their charters ASAP. Officer change forms should also be submitted soon, to reflect newly elected board members. Financial statements must be submitted soon, as well.

New Business-The DA reminded presidents about the importance of doing background checks in a timely manner.

-Leagues are reminded to check the Items Due District matrix, to make sure they have completed all requirements in a timely manner.

-The district budget was presented by Treasurer, John Martin. Presidents were asked to consider what, if any, changes they would like to make in the league assessments this year.

-Leagues are encouraged to have their safety officers review their safety plans for the 2010 season. The ASAP meeting with Brad Arbaugh will be held on Jan. 13.

-A list of district sponsored clinics was distributed. (The Big Al clinic date to be confirmed.)

-Presidents were encouraged to look at the tournament rotation, to determine which tournament they will be responsible for hosting. Exchanges between leagues can be arranged, but should be planned early.

-There was a lengthy discussion about how to administer a district program that will include both 80' and 90' baseball program. It was determined that we will have an 80' and a 90' program, but details involving individual leagues remain to be worked out.
