## **Lake Washington School District Resource Center (LWSD)**

**Location:** 16250 NE 74<sup>th</sup> Street, Redmond, WA 98052

**Directions:** Heading east on 520, (travelling towards Redmond), take the West Lake Sammamish Parkway exit. At the traffic light at the bottom of the ramp, turn left onto West Lake Way. Head northerly to the first traffic light and turn right onto NE Leary Way. Head northeasterly to the traffic light at Bear Creek Parkway turn right and then take the first left onto NE 74<sup>th</sup> Street. The building is a large modern brick office building on the corner of Bear Creek Parkway and NE 74<sup>th</sup> Street. Enter through the street entrance.

## **VMAC – The Seattle Seahawks Practice Facility – Renton**

**(A 90,000 square foot turf facility w/ 100 foot ceilings)**

**Location:** 12 Seahawks Way, Renton, Washington 98056

**Directions:** (From Route I405 South) Take the NE 44th Street exit (Exit 7) at the top of the ramp, turn right onto NE44th and then take an immediate right onto Seahawks Drive. The VMAC is a large green building on your left.

(From I405 North) Take the NE44th Street exit (Exit 7) at the top of the ramp turn left onto NE44th Street, cross over Route I5, take a right onto Seahawks Drive. The VMAC is a large green building on your left.
